"I come to the garden alone while the dew is still on the roses. And the voice I hear falling on my ear the Son of God discloses..." Nature has lessons to impart. "Trees don't sit around and worry about forest fires. The water in the pond doesn't fret over turbulence it encountered a few miles upstream. And I have never seen a butterfly pry into the affairs of its fellows. All of creation is going about the business of living. If I keep my eyes open, I can learn to do the same." [Courage to Change, p.190]

I close with the haunting poem "The Peace of Wild Things" by Wendell Berry

*When despair grows in me
and I wake in the middle of the night at the least sound
in fear of what my life and my children's live may be,
I go and lie down where the wood drake
rests in his beauty on the water, and the great heron feeds.
I come into the peace of wild things
who do not tax their lives with forethought
of grief. I come into the presence of still water.
And I feel above me the day-blind stars
waiting for their light. For a time
I rest in the grace of the world, and I am free*

Lake Superior Interfaith Community Church Elections for 2011- September 18

This fall we will be electing 4 trustees and a vice president. All board members must also be voting members of the church. Outgoing trustees include Sue Brewer, Rebecca Lee, Mike Walke and Louise Pell. (Rebecca is not completing her term as she will be moving from the area this fall.)

The duties of the Vice President and Trustees are as follows:

Vice President: Shall perform all the duties of the President in his/her absence or during disability and shall be responsible for scheduling the healing part of the service. Term of Service is one year with a maximum of 3 consecutive years served.

The Vice President has a vote on the Board of Directors

Trustee: There are 7 trustees. They, along with the President and Vice President, comprise the decision-making body for the church, the church Board of Directors. Scope of decisions include managing our money, maintenance and improvements to the building and grounds, assurance of continued operations of the music, meals, Sunday Service, website and educational programming along with interactions with the broader community. The 7 trustees elect a treasurer and a secretary from among themselves. Currently, the term for a trustee is 3 years. Trustees may not serve consecutive terms.

Sue Brewer is our current board secretary and Louise Pell is our current treasurer so both of these offices will be open in the fall.
